The Boy Scouts of America places the greatest importance on creating the most secure environment possible for our youth members. To maintain such an environment, the BSA developed numerous procedural and leadership selection policies and provides parents and leaders with resources for the [Cub Scout](#), [Boy Scout](#), and [Venturing](#) programs.

Youth Protection Training (YPT) one way the BSA details the rules that are in place when adults associate with youth in the program. It emphasizes NO one-on-one interaction with youth and requires 2-deep leadership at all times. Other topics covered include the BSA's Youth Protection policies, kinds of abuse, signs of abuse, how to respond to disclosure of abuse, and proper reporting procedures.

YPT2 Youth Protection Training is required for all BSA registered volunteers.

A YPT2 Certificate must be submitted with your adult application.

If a volunteer's Youth Protection Training record is not current at the time of recharter, the volunteer will not be reregistered.

You do not need to be a registered member or have a member ID to take Youth Protection Training.

We STRONGLY encourage ALL Parents to take the NEW Youth Protection Training.

To take Youth Protection training go to www.my.scouting.org and create an account. Once logged in at www.my.scouting.org - the YPT training will be on the right hand side. Just click on it to take the Youth Protection Training.

Upon completion, **PRINT** your Certificate of Completion and save it in PDF.

Please submit your Completion Certificate with your volunteer application. Be sure to complete all questions on the BSA Adult Application (including right side) and complete and sign the **Background Check Authorization** (page 9 of application packet).

When your volunteer application is approved, you will receive a BSA membership ID number.

The adult membership fee of \$45 yearly is paid by the Troop with funds raised by the scouts in their yearly fundraising efforts. If you wish to pay this fee, please make payment to the Troop Treasurer.
